12 later promoted to the position of director; in this capacity, Mr.
13 Madera helped communities in economically distressed areas on the
14 Texas-Mexico border to access TWDB financial assistance for
15 adequate water and sewer services; and

17 administrator for the Office of Project Finance and Construction
18 Assistance in September 2002, and his dedication and skill have

22 residents as both president and trustee of the Eagle Pass
