R E S O L U T I O N

1           WHEREAS, Christian Diaz and his associates have established  
2 the Buffalo Gap Fine Arts Center for Education near Abilene, and  
3 supporters of this exciting new project gathered at the site on  
4 March 31, 2006, for an open house; and

5           WHEREAS, Nestled among the beautiful 200-year-old oak and  
6 pecan trees of the Texas hills south of Abilene known as the Buffalo  
7 Gap, the center will not only house well-known artists and  
8 craftsmen but also consist of unique shops and an entertainment  
9 home, as well as provide a variety of educational opportunities for  
10 aspiring artists in the fields of painting, sculpture, photography,  
11 pottery, music, and literature; located at the Plaza of Buffalo  
12 Gap, adjacent to a community school, the arts center will also allow  
13 young people to experience and enjoy daily lectures in art; and

14           WHEREAS, The entire plan was envisioned by Mr. Diaz, a  
15 distinguished artist, while he was a student at Abilene Christian  
16 University and active in promoting the arts in Abilene and West  
17 Texas; he is joined in this endeavor by many friends, notably Nancy  
18 and Dusty Rhodes, his mentors for many years, as well as another  
19 longtime friend, businessman Jim Shewmaker, who is serving as  
20 onsite project manager; and

21           WHEREAS, The entire community of Buffalo Gap and the civic  
22 leaders of Abilene and surrounding cities have encouraged and  
23 applauded the creation of this new fine arts center, and many young  
24 artists, area residents, and others will greatly benefit from the

1 vision and efforts of Mr. Diaz and his colleagues; now, therefore,  
2 be it
