WHEREAS, This esteemed professional served for two years as chancellor of The Texas A&M University System before taking the helm of TTI, the largest university-affiliated transportation research organization in the country, in 1993; in the years since then, TTI has become home to nine national research centers and garnered millions of dollars in funding from state, federal, and private sponsors; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Richardson earned his bachelor's and master's degrees at Colby College in Maine and his doctoral degree from the Massachusetts Institute of Technology, all in the field of mechanical engineering; after serving for a time with the U.S. Army at the Ballistics Research Laboratory, he returned to MIT, where he eventually became associate dean of the College of Engineering; in
