R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Denison Mayor Bill Lindsay has immeasurably
2 enhanced the quality of life for countless Denison residents
3 through his many years of public service; and

4 WHEREAS, Mayor Lindsay's efforts in behalf of his fellow
5 citizens include seven years of distinguished service as mayor of
6 Denison and membership with the city council and the planning and
7 zoning commission; and

10 police facilities, and he has also played an integral role in
11 bringing vital industries to Denison and in the planning of a new

21 his country with distinction in the Vietnam War, earning a host of
22 honors, including the Distinguished Flying Cross, the Meritorious
23 Service Medal, and three Purple Hearts; and

24 WHEREAS, In his role as a public servant, Mayor Lindsay has

1 set high standards of leadership and commitment, and he leaves
2 behind a record of achievements that will continue to benefit area
3 residents for years to come; now, therefore, be it

5 Legislature, 3rd Called Session, hereby commend the Honorable Bill
6 Lindsay for his long-standing dedication to the citizens of Denison
7 and extend to him best wishes for continued success and happiness in
