1 WHEREAS, Jesus G. "Chuy" Armendariz of Alpine retired from
2 his position as a custodian with Sul Ross State University (SRSU) on
3 January 31, 2006, bringing to a close a tenure with the school that
4 spanned more than three decades; and

5 WHEREAS, A native of O'Campo, Coahuila, Mexico, and raised in
6 Lajitas, Mr. Armendariz moved to Alpine with his wife, Manuela, in
7 1971 and began his employment with SRSU two years later; over the
8 ensuing 32 years, Mr. Armendariz worked in several university
9 buildings, including the physical plant, the fine arts and science
10 facilities, and the Briscoe Administration Building, where he
11 served for 24 years; and

12 WHEREAS, Through the years, Mr. Armendariz earned a
13 reputation for his work ethic and his cheerful personality, which
14 aided him in winning a host of friends, as well as a Bar SR Bar
15 Employee Excellence Award; and

16 WHEREAS, A valued member of the Alpine community, where he
17 has raised his seven children, Chuy Armendariz may look back with
18 pride on his years at Sul Ross and know that his presence is
19 undoubtedly missed; now, therefore, be it

22 "Chuy" Armendariz on his retirement from Sul Ross State University
