1 WHEREAS, The Academic Decathlon team of Plano Senior High
2 School won the 2006 state championship and went on to place second
3 in the United States Academic Decathlon National Finals; and

4 WHEREAS, The Academic Decathlon program provides high school
5 students an opportunity to experience the challenges of rigorous
6 academic competition through participation in team activities; and

7 WHEREAS, Besting 39 other large-school teams in the state
8 meet, the Plano Senior High School group excelled in the 10-subject
9 contest, winning more than \$23,000 in scholarship money while
10 receiving 54 medals in the competition that included tests on such
11 varied subjects as economics, classical music, and the European
12 Renaissance; and

13 WHEREAS, On their school's first ever trip to the national
14 competition, the team surprised perennial favorites to earn 25
15 individual medals, team medals in all ten events, and another
16 \$1,750 in scholarships; and

17 WHEREAS, Team members include Aaditya Nagaraj, Jacob Turner,
18 Alvin Chen, Diana Shen, Rebecca Chase, Lorelei Nguyen, Lisa Wang,
19 Jenny Ding, and Erin Yu; these remarkable students were ably
20 assisted in their efforts by coaches Sheila Kolb and Bill Borowicz,
21 whose dedication and support were highly instrumental in the
22 group's success; and

23 WHEREAS, Through hard work, determination, and a deep
24 devotion to academic excellence, the Plano team has compiled a

1 stellar record of achievement, and it is appropriate to take this
2 opportunity to honor them; now, therefore, be it

3 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 79th Texas
4 Legislature, 3rd Called Session, hereby congratulate the Plano
5 Senior High School Academic Decathlon team on winning the state
6 academic decathlon championship and on placing second at the
7 national finals and extend to its members best wishes for continued
