R E S O L U T I O N

3 judge of Jim Hogg County, and this occasion offers an apt
4 opportunity to reflect on his many contributions to the community;

7 tenure in public office when he was first elected to serve as County
8 Commissioner of Precinct No. 2 in 1978, and he served in that
9 capacity through 1994; returning to the commissioners court with

11 his leadership and vision with his colleagues on the court, while
12 benefiting county residents in countless ways; and

13 WHEREAS, Judge Molina has further worked for the greater good
14 through his involvement in the Texas Association of Counties, the
15 Highway 16 Coalition, the Border Region MHMR Community Center, the
16 Border Area Nutrition Program, the South Texas Development Council,

20 her a rewarding relationship that has continued to grow in mutual

1 committed public servant and an invaluable asset to Jim Hogg
2 County, and it is indeed fitting that he be honored for his myriad
