6 where she taught first and third grades at Lubbock Christian

8 District; and

11 combined kindergarten and first-grade class for seven years; in her
12 last year of employment with Doublecreek Farm, she ran the private
13 school and taught four-year-olds; and

15 love of learning with elementary school students of Hutto
16 Independent School District; and

17 WHEREAS, Although she will be deeply missed, Sandra Bledsoe
