17 officer in the United States Army, receiving numerous commendations
18 and medals; and

20 course of his 11-year tenure at TxDOT, where he began as an
21 engineering technician III and was promoted to the position of
22 engineering specialist; and

23 WHEREAS, With a much appreciated sense of humor, Sean Hayes
24 was a good friend and a devoted husband and father who will be

1 remembered as a man of honor and integrity and will be deeply
2 missed; now, therefore, be it
