16 energy to the Friendswood ISD, working as a board trustee, a member

20 Mayor Brizendine is a devoted husband to his wife, Jo Beth, who has  
21 taught in the Friendswood ISD for 26 years, as well as a loving dad  
22 to two children, Ben and Rachel; and

23           WHEREAS, Kim Brizendine entered public service determined to  
24 make his hometown a better place, and he may indeed reflect with
