1           WHEREAS, The University of Texas at Austin's women's indoor  
2 track and field team captured the 2006 NCAA Indoor Track and Field  
3 Championships at the Randal Tyson Track Center on the campus of the  
4 University of Arkansas; and

5           WHEREAS, Led by head coach Bev Kearney, the Longhorns  
6 dominated the two-day event, scoring 51 points to outpace Stanford  
7 University's total of 36; the victory was Coach Kearney's sixth NCAA  
8 team title at Texas and her seventh overall collegiate title; and

9           WHEREAS, The Longhorns received outstanding effort from each  
10 team member, with notable performances from juniors Marshevet  
11 Hooker and Michelle Carter and the 4x400-meter relay team composed  
12 of senior Sheretta Jones, freshman Alexandria Anderson, senior  
13 LaTashia Kerr, and senior Melaine Walker; and

14           WHEREAS, With the 2006 championship title in hand, the  
15 UT-Austin women's track and field team now holds back-to-back NCAA  
16 track championships, and this impressive achievement is testament  
17 to the talent, hard work, and dedication of the team and its  
18 coaching staff; now, therefore, be it

19           RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 79th Texas  
20 Legislature, 3rd Called Session, hereby congratulate Coach Bev  
21 Kearney and The University of Texas at Austin women's indoor track  
22 and field squad on claiming the NCAA Indoor Track and Field
