16 was named Outstanding Musician at McCallum High School during his  
17 senior year, an honor he also won during his final year at Lamar  
18 Middle School; and

20 seniors in Texas, this talented young man has a bright and promising  
21 future; he plans to pursue a degree in music at the University of  
22 North Texas, an institution recognized as having the finest  
23 percussion training in the country, and he will undoubtedly
