

R E S O L U T I O N

1           WHEREAS, The family and friends of Hugh Lee Conner of Houston  
2 were greatly saddened by his passing, and we join them in reflecting  
3 on this esteemed Texan's rich and eventful life; and

4           WHEREAS, Born September 15, 1912, Mr. Conner was the eldest  
5 of 11 children, and as a youth he attended school in Brenham while  
6 learning about farming through firsthand experience at home; and

7           WHEREAS, In 1932, he moved to Houston, taking a job alongside  
8 his brother Tyree at the Houston Shoe Hospital; in the years that  
9 followed he also worked at Westheimer Furniture Company, Shell Oil  
10 Company, Dixon Gun Plant, and Brae Burn Country Club, where he  
11 developed his lifelong affinity for the game of golf; after  
12 retiring from Brae Burn in 1971, he continued to work part-time at  
13 several local country clubs for many years; and

14           WHEREAS, In addition to his love of golf, this longtime Mason  
15 was also an avid gardener, and his green thumb was the envy of his  
16 fellow horticulturists; and

17           WHEREAS, For 66 years, he enjoyed the love and companionship  
18 of his beloved wife, Georgia Patterson Conner, with whom he raised  
19 four children; he drew additional support from his community of  
20 worship at Trinity East United Methodist Church, and over the years  
21 served the congregation in many capacities, including collection  
22 steward and trustee; and

23           WHEREAS, Although his death has brought great sorrow to his  
24 loved ones, Mr. Conner has left behind many fond memories that those

1 fortunate enough to have known him will forever treasure; now,  
2 therefore, be it

3         RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 79th Texas  
4 Legislature, 3rd Called Session, hereby pay tribute to the life of  
5 Hugh Lee Conner and extend sincere sympathy to the members of his  
6 family: to his wife, Georgia P. Conner; to his children, Donald
