

R E S O L U T I O N

1           WHEREAS, Head football coach and athletic director Phil  
2 Danaher of Calallen High School reached an impressive milestone on  
3 September 9, 2005, when he recorded his 300th career victory; and

4           WHEREAS, Coach Danaher began his coaching career serving  
5 three years as an assistant coach at San Antonio Edison; he then  
6 became athletic director and head coach in Dilley, where he amassed  
7 a 25-15-2 record in four years; after leaving Dilley and before  
8 arriving at Calallen, he transformed an underachieving  
9 Hamshire-Fannett athletic program into a successful organization  
10 which garnered three football championships and twice earned  
11 runner-up honors; and

12           WHEREAS, During his impressive 22-year tenure with Calallen,  
13 Coach Danaher has posted an outstanding 244-45-2 record; his teams,  
14 which have made the playoffs for the past 21 consecutive seasons,  
15 set a state record of 16 consecutive seasons winning 10 or more  
16 games, racked up 55 straight district wins, and appeared in the  
17 state semifinals in seven of the last nine years; and

18           WHEREAS, Coach Danaher tallied his 300th victory by defeating  
19 Waco 35-14, making him only the fourth coach in Texas high school  
20 football history to accomplish this feat; and

21           WHEREAS, A source of tremendous pride to the Calallen High  
22 School community, Coach Danaher has secured his place in the annals  
23 of high school football history, and it is indeed a pleasure to  
24 recognize such an achievement; now, therefore, be it
