1 WHEREAS, The varsity lacrosse squad of St. Mark's School of
2 Texas in Dallas enjoyed its finest season ever in 2006, finishing
3 the regular season undefeated and ranked number one in the Lone Star
4 State; and

5 WHEREAS, The Lions, who will play in the Lax.com National
6 Championship Tournament in New York in June, are ranked 27th in the
7 nation and are one of just 16 teams invited to compete in the
8 national championship tournament; and

9 WHEREAS, Averaging 13.2 goals per game, while holding
10 opponents to just 7.5 goals per game, the Lions scored impressive
11 victories over Highland Park and Episcopal School of Dallas during
12 the 2006 campaign; the team also had an opportunity to compete
13 against the nation's top team, the Boys' Latin School of Maryland,
14 in a competitive 18-11 match during its spring break visit to
15 Florida; and

17 overcoming the loss of all-state goalkeeper and beloved teammate
18 Brendan Court, whose memory helped drive the Lions to their third
19 consecutive SPC Championship and a sterling 14-1 overall record;

14 Spencer Branch; all-district honorees Robert Neely, George
15 Lauinger, and Heath Townsend; and honorable mention all-district
16 honorees Holt Cutler, Charlie Dorsaneo, Kaleb Deslorieux, and
17 Hollis Meyer; in addition, Mr. Eberhart, Mr. Jordan, Mr. Neely,
18 Mr. Branch, and Mr. Meyer earned all-SPC recognition; and

19 WHEREAS, With the national tournament just a few weeks away,
20 the St. Mark's Lions are poised to extend their memorable season and
21 continue to make school history, and the members of this chamber are
22 proud to wish them well as they represent the Lone Star State in New
