2 Legislature, the Honorable Carlos I. Uresti is relinquishing his
3 seat in the Texas House of Representatives, and this occasion

6 Antonio native has demonstrated strong leadership skills on the
7 floor, and currently serves as the chairman of the House Committee

10 Committee on Human Services and served on the House Select
11 Committee on State Health Care Expenditures and the Committees on
12 Public Health, Higher Education, Judicial Affairs, and Elections,
