Alonzo, were continually inspired by the example of 13 their strong, industrious, and loving mother who was the foundation 14 of the family; and WHEREAS, Speaking of his mother's influence on himself and 15 his siblings, Representative Alonzo has said that, "We are who we 16 are because of her"; Mrs. Alonzo not only stressed the importance of 17 basic qualities such as honesty and responsibility, but also taught 18 her children to value civic and political ideals such as equality 19 and civil rights and to work for the betterment of all; and 20 21 WHEREAS, Mrs. Alonzo was deeply saddened by the loss of her 22 husband, Emeterio, in the late 1970s, but she found solace in the love of her family and the friendship of her many other 23 acquaintances; she was a frequent and most welcome visitor to the 24
