A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

<u>L</u>	AN ACT

- 2 relating to requiring the division of emergency management to
- 3 coordinate the creation of certain medical and special needs
- 4 shelters.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 418.043, Government Code, is amended to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 418.043. OTHER POWERS AND DUTIES. The division shall:
- 9 (1) determine requirements of the state and its
- 10 political subdivisions for food, clothing, and other necessities in
- 11 event of a disaster;
- 12 (2) procure and position supplies, medicines,
- 13 materials, and equipment;
- 14 (3) adopt standards and requirements for local and
- interjurisdictional emergency management plans;
- 16 (4) periodically review local and interjurisdictional
- 17 emergency management plans;
- 18 (5) coordinate deployment of mobile support units;
- 19 (6) establish and operate training programs and
- 20 programs of public information or assist political subdivisions and
- 21 emergency management agencies to establish and operate the
- 22 programs;
- 23 (7) make surveys of public and private industries,
- 24 resources, and facilities in the state that are necessary to carry

- out the purposes of this chapter;
- 2 (8) plan and make arrangements for the availability
- 3 and use of any private facilities, services, and property and
- 4 provide for payment for use under terms and conditions agreed on if
- 5 the facilities are used and payment is necessary;
- 6 (9) establish a register of persons with types of
- 7 training and skills important in disaster mitigation,
- 8 preparedness, response, and recovery;
- 9 (10) establish a register of mobile and construction
- 10 equipment and temporary housing available for use in a disaster;
- 11 (11) prepare, for issuance by the governor, executive
- 12 orders and regulations necessary or appropriate in coping with
- 13 disasters;
- 14 (12) cooperate with the federal government and any
- 15 public or private agency or entity in achieving any purpose of this
- 16 chapter and in implementing programs for disaster mitigation,
- 17 preparation, response, and recovery; [and]
- 18 (13) plan and make arrangements for the availability
- 19 and use of medical and dental units, as that term is defined by
- 20 Section 61.003, Education Code, as shelters for use in a disaster
- 21 for persons with medical or other special needs; and
- $\underline{\text{(14)}}$ do other things necessary, incidental, or
- 23 appropriate for the implementation of this chapter.
- 24 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 25 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 26 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 27 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

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1 Act takes effect September 1, 2006.
