A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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- 2 relating to exemptions from the sales tax.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 151.326, Tax Code, is
- 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 151.326. CLOTHING AND FOOTWEAR FOR LIMITED PERIODS
- 7 [PERIOD].
- 8 SECTION 2. Section 151.326(a), Tax Code, is amended to read
- 9 as follows:
- 10 (a) The sale of an article of clothing or footwear designed
- 11 to be worn on or about the human body is exempted from the taxes
- 12 imposed by this chapter if:
- 13 (1) the sales price of the article is less than \$100;
- 14 and
- 15 (2) the sale takes place during:
- 16 (A) a period beginning at 12:01 a.m. on the first
- 17 Friday in August and ending at 12 midnight on the following Sunday;
- 18 <u>or</u>
- 19 (B) a period beginning at 12:01 a.m. on the first
- 20 Friday in December and ending at 12 midnight on the following
- 21 Sunday.
- SECTION 3. Subchapter H, Chapter 151, Tax Code, is amended
- 23 by adding Section 151.327 to read as follows:
- Sec. 151.327. SCHOOL SUPPLIES FOR LIMITED PERIODS. (a) The

- 1 sale or storage, use, or other consumption of a school supply,
- 2 including a backpack, is exempted from the taxes imposed by this
- 3 chapter if the school supply is purchased:
- 4 (1) for use by a student in a class in a public or
- 5 private elementary or secondary school;
- 6 (2) during a period described by Section
- 7 151.326(a)(2); and
- 8 (3) for a sales price of less than \$100 per item.
- 9 (b) The comptroller shall adopt rules specifying the school
- 10 supplies that are exempt from taxation under this section.
- 11 (c) The exemption provided by this section does not apply to
- 12 the purchase of a textbook.
- SECTION 4. The changes in law made by this Act do not affect
- 14 tax liability accruing before the effective date of this Act. That
- 15 liability continues in effect as if this Act had not been enacted,
- 16 and the former law is continued in effect for the collection of
- 17 taxes due and for civil and criminal enforcement of the liability of
- 18 those taxes.
- 19 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2006.
