3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 11.253(d), Education Code, is amended to
5	read as follows:
6	(d) Each campus improvement plan must:
7	(1) assess the academic achievement for each student
8	in the school using the academic excellence indicator system as
9	described by Section 39.051;
10	(2) set the campus performance objectives based on the
11	academic excellence indicator system, including objectives for

- academic excellence indicator system, including objectives for special needs populations, including students in special education programs under Subchapter A, Chapter 29;
- 14 (3) identify how the campus goals will be met for each student;
- 16 (4) determine the resources needed to implement the 17 plan;
- 18 (5) identify staff needed to implement the plan;
- 19 (6) set timelines for reaching the goals;
- 20 (7) measure progress toward the performance 21 objectives periodically to ensure that the plan is resulting in 22 academic improvement;
- 23 (8) <u>establish</u> [<u>include</u>] goals and methods for violence 24 prevention and intervention, dropout deterrence, and academic

- 10 and training in nurturing and providing positive discipline to a

- 12 SECTION 2. Section 11.253(d), Education Code, as amended by
- 13 this Act, applies to campus improvement plans beginning with campus
- improvement plans for the 2006-2007 school year.
- 15 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 16 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 19 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the
- 20 legislative session.
