WHEREAS, Beachgoers should follow these simple rules: never swim alone, always swim near a lifeguard, never drink alcohol before swimming, respect the power of the surf, and learn to swim; and

WHEREAS, To increase public safety, an annual reminder of the joys and hazards associated with the aquatic environment is most appropriate at the commencement of the busy summer beach season; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Senate of the State of Texas, 79th Legislature, 3rd Called Session, hereby recognize May 22 through 29, 2006, as National Beach Safety Week in Galveston and commend the many individuals who contribute to the safety of beachgoers during the summer beach season.
