WHEREAS, A devout Catholic, Mike was an active member of Sacred Heart Catholic Church, and he earned a master's degree in theology from Saint Mary's University in 2005; he was ordained as a deacon for the Diocese of Austin and was assigned to Sacred Heart Catholic Church, and he served as a volunteer with the Saint Vincent de Paul Society for 36 years; and

WHEREAS, Mike enriched all who knew him with his love and compassion, his warmth and kindness, and his enthusiasm and vitality; and

WHEREAS, A devoted husband, father, and grandfather, Mike leaves behind memories that will be cherished forever by his family and many friends; now, therefore, be it
