A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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- 2 relating to an electronic database of major state contracts and
- 3 related documents.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 2177.0001 and 2177.001, Government
- 6 Code, are reenacted as Section 2177.001, Government Code, and
- 7 amended to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 2177.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:
- 9 (1) "Department" means the Department of Information
- 10 Resources.
- 11 (2) "Electronic procurement system" means the
- 12 electronic system for procuring goods and services consisting of
- 13 the electronic procurement marketplace created under Subchapter B
- 14 and the electronic commerce network created under Subchapter C.
- 15 (3) $[\frac{1}{1}]$ "Institution of higher education" has the
- meaning assigned by Section 61.003, Education Code.
- 17 $\underline{(4)}$ [$\underline{(2)}$] "Political subdivision" includes a school
- 18 district.
- (5) [(3)] "State agency" has the meaning assigned by
- 20 Section 2054.003, except that the term does not include a
- 21 university system or institution of higher education [or an agency
- 22 identified in Section 531.001(4)].
- SECTION 2. Section 2177.051(a), Government Code, is amended
- 24 to read as follows:

- The <u>commission</u> [department] shall establish, and the 1 (a) 2 <u>department shall</u> manage, the electronic infrastructure of an electronic procurement marketplace. The commission shall manage 3 4 administer the content of the electronic procurement marketplace in accordance with this subtitle. The department or 5 6 commission, as appropriate, may enter into contracts with private or public entities to establish or maintain all or part of the 7 databases comprising the marketplace, to the extent feasible, 8 9 including contracts to procure hardware or software. department or commission, as appropriate, shall procure all goods 10 and services related to the marketplace through a competitive 11 selection process appropriate for the good or service being 12 acquired. 13
- SECTION 3. Subchapter B, Chapter 2177, Government Code, is amended by adding Section 2177.052 to read as follows:
- Sec. 2177.052. MAJOR CONTRACTS. (a) In this section,

 "major contract" means a contract that has a value that is expected

 to be at least \$5 million computed as the:
- 19 (1) initial value of the contract; or
- 20 (2) total value of the contract after all potential 21 term extensions.
- 22 (b) Each state agency shall provide the commission copies of the following documents:
- (1) each major contract entered into by the agency;
- 25 and
- 26 (2) each request for proposal, invitation to bid, or
- 27 comparable solicitation related to the major contract.

- 1 (c) The commission shall include in the information posted
- 2 <u>on the electronic procurement marketplace:</u>
- 3 (1) each major contract of a state agency, including
- 4 the commission; and
- 5 (2) each request for proposal, invitation to bid, or
- 6 comparable solicitation related to the major contract.
- 7 (d) The commission shall allow Texas governmental entities,
- 8 including legislative entities, access to the information posted
- 9 under this section.
- 10 (e) The commission shall allow public access to the
- information posted under this section, except for information that
- is not subject to disclosure under Chapter 552. Information that is
- 13 <u>not subject to disclosure under Chapter 552 must be referenced in an</u>
- 14 appendix that generally describes the information without
- 15 <u>disclosing the specific content of the information.</u>
- 16 <u>(f) The commission shall make the information searchable by</u>
- 17 contract value, state agency, and vendor. The commission may make
- 18 the information searchable by other subjects as appropriate.
- 19 SECTION 4. (a) Not later than December 31, 2005, the Texas
- 20 Building and Procurement Commission shall establish or modify the
- 21 electronic procurement marketplace as necessary to comply with
- 22 Section 2177.052, Government Code, as added by this Act.
- 23 (b) A state agency is not required to comply with Section
- 24 2177.052, Government Code, as added by this Act, for a contract
- 25 entered into before the effective date of this Act.
- 26 (c) Not later than June 1, 2006, the Texas Building and
- 27 Procurement Commission and each affected state agency shall meet

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- 1 the requirements of Section 2177.052, Government Code, as added by
- 2 this Act. The commission by rule may provide guidance regarding
- 3 which major contracts entered into before the effective date of
- 4 this Act, together with their related documents, may be provided to
- 5 the commission for posting under Section 2177.052.
- 6 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 7 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 8 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 9 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 10 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
