5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 101, Alcoholic Beverage
7	Code, is amended by adding Section 101.76 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 101.76. LIMITATION ON ALCOHOL CONTENT OF DRINKS
9	SERVED. (a) The holder of a permit or license that authorizes the
10	holder to serve alcoholic beverages for on-premises consumption may
11	not serve a drink that contains more than one-half ounce of absolute
12	alcohol or the equivalent.
13	(b) A person who violates this section commits an offense.
14	(c) An offense under this section is a Class A misdemeanor.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
