SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only to the penalty for an offense under Chapter 49, Penal Code, that is committed on or after the effective date of this Act. The penalty for an offense under Chapter 49, Penal Code, that was committed before the effective date of this Act is covered by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the effective date of this Act if
