1-8 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-9 AN ACT

1-10 relating to the designation of portions of Interstate Highway 20
1-11 inside Dallas and Tarrant Counties as the Ronald Reagan Memorial
1-12 Highway.

1-13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-14 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 225, Transportation Code,
1-15 is amended by adding Section 225.059 to read as follows:

1-16 Sec. 225.059. RONALD REAGAN MEMORIAL HIGHWAY. (a) The part
1-17 of Interstate Highway 20 located between the Tarrant-Parker County
1-18 Line and the eastern municipal boundary of Grand Prairie is
1-19 designated as the Ronald Reagan Memorial Highway.

1-20 (b) The department shall design and construct memorial
1-21 markers indicating the highway number, the designation as the
1-22 Ronald Reagan Memorial Highway, and any other appropriate
1-23 information.

1-24 (c) The department shall erect a marker at each end of the
1-25 highway and at appropriate intermediate sites along the highway.

1-26 (d) Notwithstanding Subsections (b) and (c), the department
1-27 is required to design, construct, and erect the markers only to the
1-28 extent that money is available for this purpose from a grant or
1-29 donation of private funds.

1-30 (e) Funds collected under Section 225.021 for the purpose of
1-31 implementing this Section, shall be deposited to the credit of the
1-32 state highway fund.

1-33 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
