A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2	relating to the dates on which elections may be held.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 41.001(a), Election Code, as amended by
5	Section 1, Chapter 1, Acts of the 78th Legislature, 3rd Called
6	Session, 2003, is amended to read as follows:
7	(a) Except as otherwise provided by this subchapter, each
8	general or special election in this state shall be held on one of
9	the following dates:
10	(1) [the first Saturday in February;
11	$\left[\frac{(2)}{(2)}\right]$ the first Saturday in May;
12	[(3) the second Saturday in September;] or
13	(2) [(4)] the first Tuesday after the first Monday in
14	November.
15	SECTION 2. Section 41.001(b), Election Code, is amended to
16	read as follows:
17	(b) Subsection (a) does not apply to:
18	(1) a runoff election;
19	(2) [an election for the issuance or assumption of
20	bonds for any purpose authorized by law relating to public schools

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or colleges or the levy of a tax for the maintenance of a public

school or college, if the governing body of the political

subdivision having jurisdiction of the public school or college

issuing or assuming the bonds or levying the tax:

- [(A) by resolution, order, or ordinance, finds
 that holding the election on a date other than a uniform election
 date is in the public interest, which finding is conclusive and
- 4 incontestable; and
- [(B) the election is the only election of the type
 described by this subdivision held by that political subdivision on
- 7 a date other than a uniform election date during the state fiscal
- 8 biennium;
- 9 [(3)] an election to resolve a tie vote;
- 10 $\underline{(3)}$ [$\overline{(4)}$] an election held under an order of a court or other tribunal;
- 12 $\underline{(4)}$ [$\overline{(5)}$] an emergency election ordered under Section 13 41.0011;
- 14 <u>(5)</u> [(6)] an expedited election to fill a vacancy in the legislature held under Section 203.013; or
- (6) (7) an election held under a statute that expressly provides that the requirement of Subsection (a) does not apply to the election.
- SECTION 3. Section 41.0052(a), Election Code, as amended by
 Chapters 1074 and 1315, Acts of the 78th Legislature, Regular
 Session, 2003, is reenacted and amended to read as follows:
- 22 (a) The governing body of a political subdivision other than 23 a county may, not later than December 31, 2005 [2004], change the 24 date on which it holds its general election for officers to another 25 authorized uniform election date.
- SECTION 4. Section 41.253(b), Education Code, is amended to read as follows:

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- 1 (b) The transitional board of trustees shall divide the
- 2 consolidated district into nine single-member trustee districts in
- 3 accordance with the procedures provided by Section 11.052. The
- 4 transitional board shall order an election for the initial board of
- 5 trustees to be held on the first May [February] uniform election
- 6 date after the effective date of a consolidation order.
- 7 SECTION 5. Section 49.103(b), Water Code, is amended to
- 8 read as follows:
- 9 (b) An election shall be held on the uniform election date,
- 10 established by the Election Code, in [either February or] May of
- 11 each even-numbered year to elect the appropriate number of
- 12 directors.
- 13 SECTION 6. Section 56.804(a), Water Code, is amended to
- 14 read as follows:
- 15 (a) The election shall be held on a uniform election day in
- 16 [February or] May.
- SECTION 7. Sections 41.001(d) and (e), Election Code, are
- 18 repealed.
- 19 SECTION 8. Not later than December 31, 2005, a political
- 20 subdivision that before October 1, 2005, held its general election
- 21 for officers on the February or September uniform election date
- 22 shall change the election date as permitted by Section 41.0052,
- 23 Election Code, as reenacted and amended by Section 3 of this Act, to
- 24 a date authorized by Section 41.001, Election Code, as amended by
- 25 Section 1 of this Act.
- 26 SECTION 9. This Act applies only to an election ordered on
- or after October 1, 2005.

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1 SECTION 10. This Act takes effect October 1, 2005.
