- 2 relating to the penalty for evasion of process.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Article 20.14, Code of Criminal Procedure, is 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 Art. 20.14. EVASION OF PROCESS. If it be made to appear
- 7 satisfactorily to the court that a witness for whom an attachment
- 8 has been issued to go before the grand jury is in any manner
- 9 wilfully evading the service of such summons or attachment, the
- 10 court may fine such witness, as for contempt, an amount not
- 11 exceeding five hundred dollars for each day that the witness evades
- 12 <u>service</u>.
- SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 14 to an evasion of service of a summons or attachment issued by a
- 15 court on or after September 1, 2005. An evasion of service of a
- summons or attachment issued by a court before September 1, 2005, is
- 17 governed by the law in effect immediately before that date, and the
- 18 former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
