1-8 relating to exempting school districts from certain mold assessor
1-9 and remediation licensing requirements.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Section 1958.155, Occupations Code, is amended
1-12 by adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:

1-13 (d) This section does not apply to a license holder employed
1-14 by a school district working on a project for that school district.

1-15 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-16 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-19 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
