## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT

- 2 relating to service of public school superintendents, principals,
- 3 assistant principals, and other senior administrators as
- 4 substitute teachers.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 11, Education Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 11.203 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 11.203. ADMINISTRATOR SERVICE AS SUBSTITUTE
- 9 TEACHER. Each superintendent, principal, assistant principal, and
- 10 other senior administrator in a school district shall serve as a
- 11 substitute teacher for a class in the district for at least two days
- during each school year.
- SECTION 2. The heading to Subchapter E, Chapter 11,
- 14 Education Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 15 SUBCHAPTER E. ADMINISTRATORS [SUPERINTENDENTS AND PRINCIPALS]
- SECTION 3. This Act applies beginning with the 2005-2006
- 17 school year.
- 18 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
