## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the authority of a municipality to alter speed limits in

3 an urban district within the municipality.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 545.356, Transportation Code, is amended

by adding Subsection (b-1) and amending Subsection (c) to read as

7 follows:

- 8 (b-1) The governing body of a municipality, for a highway or
- 9 a part of a highway in an urban district in the municipality that is
- 10 not an officially designated or marked highway or road of the state
- 11 <u>highway system, may declare a lower speed limit of not less than 25</u>
- 12 miles per hour, if the governing body determines that the prima
- 13 <u>facie speed limit on the highway is unreasonable or unsafe.</u>
- 14 (c) A prima facie speed limit that is altered by the
- 15 governing body of a municipality under Subsection (b) or (b-1) is
- 16 effective when the governing body erects signs giving notice of the
- 17 new limit and at all times or at other times as determined.
- 18 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
