- 5 SECTION 1. Section 223.0041(c), Transportation Code, is
- 7 (c) <u>If</u> [For a maintenance contract involving an amount less
- 8 than \$100,000, if] the lowest bidder withdraws its bid prior to
- 9 contract award or fails to execute the contract, the director may
- 10 recommend to the commission that the contract be awarded to the
- 11 second lowest bidder. The commission may award the [maintenance]
- 12 contract to the second lowest bidder if the second lowest bidder
- agrees to accept a bid price that is within five percent of the bid
- 14 price [the unit bid prices] of the lowest bidder. The commission
- 15 shall adopt rules governing the conditions under which the
- department will allow the withdrawal of the bid of the lowest bidder
- 17 and consider awarding a [maintenance] contract to the second lowest
- 18 bidder.

- 19 SECTION 2. (a) The changes in law made by this Act to the
- 20 Texas Department of Transportation's contract procedures apply
- 21 only to a highway project for which the department first solicits
- 22 bids on or after September 1, 2005.
- 23 (b) A highway project for which the Texas Department of
- 24 Transportation first solicited bids before September 1, 2005, is

- 1 governed by the law as it existed immediately before the effective
- 2 date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for that
- 3 purpose.
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
