- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 42.154(a), Education Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (a) For each full-time equivalent student <u>in grades seven</u>
- 8 through 12 in average daily attendance in an approved career and
- 9 technology education program, including a [in grades nine through
- 10 12 or in career and technology education program [programs] for
- 11 students with disabilities [in grades seven through 12], a district
- 12 is entitled to an annual allotment equal to the adjusted basic
- allotment multiplied by a weight of 1.37 [1.35].
- 14 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
