8	SUPERINTENDENT. (a) The superintendent of an independent school						
9	district shall file a verified financial statement with:						
10	(1) the board of trustees of the district; and						
11	(2) the Texas Ethics Commission.						
12	(b) A financial statement filed under Subsection (a) must						
13	include the information prescribed by Section 572.023(b)(1),

6	(b) For purposes of this section, a superintendent or a							
7	retired superintendent has a substantial interest in a business							
8	entity if the superintendent would have a substantial interest in							
9	that business entity under Section 171.002(a), Local Government							
10	<u>Code.</u>							
11	(c) The board of trustees of a school district may not enter							
12	into, with the superintendent, with a person who has retired from							
13	service as the superintendent of the district during the three-year							
14	period preceding the date on which the contract is entered into, or							

15 with a business entity in which the superintendent or retired 16 superintendent has a substantial interest, a contract under which 17 the district agrees to pay for services provided to the district.

SECTION 3. Section 11.2011, Education Code, as added by this Act, applies beginning January 1, 2007. A superintendent subject to Section 11.2011, Education Code, as added by this Act, is not required to include financial activity occurring before January 1, 2006, in a verified financial statement required under Section 11.2011, Education Code, as added by this Act.

SECTION 4. Section 44.045, Education Code, as added by this Act, applies only to a contract executed on or after September 1, 2005. A contract executed before September 1, 2005, is governed by the law as it existed on the date the contract was executed, and the
