reasonable discipline of a child is liable in the amounts described 1 2 by Section 601.072(a), Transportation Code, for damages proximately caused by the negligent conduct of the child in the 3 4 operation of a motor vehicle if: (1) the child's conduct is not attributable to the 5 6 negligent failure of the parent or other person to exercise that 7 duty; 8 (2) the motor vehicle: 9 (A) belongs to the child or to the person with the duty of control and reasonable discipline of the child or another 10 member of that person's household; or 11 12 (B) was, at the time of the conduct, operated by the child with that person's knowledge or permission; and 13 (3) the damages are not covered by financial 14 15 responsibility required by Section 601.051, Transportation Code. 16 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only to a cause of action that accrues on or after the effective date of 17 this Act. A cause of action that accrues before the effective date 18 of this Act is governed by the law in effect immediately before that 19 date, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose. 20 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
