5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 61, Education Code, is 7 amended by adding Section 61.0814 to read as follows:

EXAMINATION INSTRUCTION REQUIREMENT. (a) The board shall conduct a study to evaluate the feasibility of requiring an institution of higher education that offers a program leading to a doctor of medicine or doctor of osteopathy degree or to a degree that satisfies the educational requirement for licensure as a registered nurse to require a student enrolled in the degree program to complete basic instruction regarding medical examination practices and issues regarding sexual assault, including the dynamics and effects of being a victim of sexual assault as a prerequisite to receiving the degree.

- 19 <u>(b) The board shall complete the study and report the</u>
 20 <u>results of the study to the legislature on or before December 31,</u>
 21 <u>2006.</u>
- (c) This section expires September 1, 2007.
- 23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
