## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the award of academic credit to a student at an
3	institution of higher education for the completion of certain
4	military training.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 51, Education Code, is
7	amended by adding Section 51.3041 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 51.3041. AWARD OF COURSE CREDIT FOR MILITARY TRAINING.
9	(a) In this section, "institution of higher education" has the
10	meaning assigned by Section 61.003.

- 11 (b) An institution of higher education shall consider, in
  12 determining whether to award to a student course credit toward a
  13 degree offered by the institution for the student's completion of
  14 certain military training:
- 15 <u>(1) any official military record presented to the</u> 16 institution by the student that:
- (A) describes the substance of the training completed by the student; and
- 19 <u>(B) verifies the student's successful completion</u>
  20 <u>of that training; and</u>
- (2) whether the substance of that training satisfies
  the purpose of the course for which the student seeks credit as
  described in the institution's course catalog.
- 24 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

- 1 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 4 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
