5	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 11, Alcoholic Beverage
6	Code, is amended by adding Section 11.461 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 11.461. CERTAIN WINE AND BEER RETAILER'S PERMITS:
8	ADDITIONAL GROUNDS FOR REFUSAL TO RENEW. (a) This section applies
9	only to a wine and beer retailer's permit for premises located in a
10	municipality:
11	(1) with a population of 1.5 million or more; and
12	(2) that has not adopted a comprehensive zoning
13	ordinance under Subchapter A, Chapter 211, Local Government Code.
14	(b) The commission or administrator may refuse to issue a
15	renewal wine and beer retailer's permit for a premises located
16	within 300 feet of a church, school, or day-care center or
17	child-care facility, as that distance is determined under Sections
18	109.33 and 109.331, if the commission or administrator determines
19	after a hearing that the operation of the premises has an adverse
20	effect on the health, safety, or welfare of individuals attending

- 2 (b) An application for renewal of a wine and beer retailer's
- 3 permit that is filed and approved before the effective date of this
- 4 Act is governed by the law in effect immediately before that date,
- 5 and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 6 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 7 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 8 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 9 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 10 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
