5 SECTION 1. Section 143.027(a), Local Government Code, is 6 amended to read as follows:

7 (a) A person appointed to a beginning position in the fire 8 or police department must serve a probationary period of <u>18 months</u> 9 [one year] beginning on that person's date of employment as a fire

11 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act to Section

fighter, police officer, or academy trainee.

12 143.027(a), Local Government Code, applies only to a person whose

date of employment for purposes of that law is on or after the

14 effective date of this Act. A person whose date of employment for

15 purposes of that law is before the effective date of this Act is

governed by the law in effect immediately before the effective date

of this Act, and the former law is continued in effect for that

18 purpose.

19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

23 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
