A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to a project of a development corporation in connection 3 with a military base. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Section 2(11), Development Corporation Act of 6 1979 (Article 5190.6, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes), is amended to read as follows: 7 (11) [(A)] "Project" shall mean the land, buildings, 8 equipment, facilities, expenditures, targeted infrastructure, and 9 improvements (one or more) that are for the creation or retention of 10 11 primary jobs and that are found by the board of directors to be 12 required or suitable for the development, retention, or expansion 13 manufacturing and industrial facilities, research of and 14 development facilities, transportation facilities (including but not limited to airports, ports, mass commuting facilities, and 15 parking facilities), sewage or solid waste disposal facilities, 16 recycling facilities, air or water pollution control facilities, 17 18 facilities for the furnishing of water to the general public, distribution centers, small warehouse facilities capable of 19 serving as decentralized storage and distribution centers, primary 20 21 job training facilities for use by institutions of higher 22 education, and regional or national corporate headquarters 23 facilities. 24

"Project" also includes job training required or

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suitable for the promotion of development and expansion of business enterprises and other enterprises described by this Act, as provided by Section 38 of this Act.

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4 "Project" also includes expenditures found by the board 5 of directors to be required or suitable for infrastructure 6 necessary to promote or develop new or expanded business enterprises limited to streets and roads, rail spurs, water and 7 8 electric utilities, gas utilities, drainage and related improvements, and telecommunications and Internet improvements. 9

10 <u>"Project" also includes the land, buildings, equipment,</u> 11 <u>facilities, expenditures, targeted infrastructure, and</u> 12 <u>improvements that are found by the board of directors to be required</u> 13 <u>or suitable for the promotion or support of a military base in</u> 14 <u>active use to prevent the possible future closure or realignment of</u> 15 <u>the base.</u>

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2005.

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
