A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the conditions of community supervision for certain 3 persons convicted of an intoxication offense.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
SECTION 1. Section 13(a), Article 42.12, Code of Criminal
Procedure, is amended to read as follows:

7 (a) A judge granting community supervision to a defendant
8 convicted of an offense under Chapter 49, Penal Code, shall require
9 as a condition of community supervision that the defendant submit
10 to:

11 (1)not less than 72 hours [three days] of continuous 12 confinement in county jail if the defendant was punished under Section 49.09(a); not less than five days of confinement in county 13 jail if the defendant was punished under Section 49.09(a) and was 14 subject to Section 49.09(h); not less than 10 days of confinement in 15 county jail if the defendant was punished under Section 49.09(b) or 16 (c); or not less than 30 days of confinement in county jail if the 17 defendant was convicted under Section 49.07; and 18

(2) an evaluation by a supervision officer or by a person, program, or facility approved by the Texas Commission on Alcohol and Drug Abuse for the purpose of having the facility prescribe and carry out a course of conduct necessary for the rehabilitation of the defendant's drug or alcohol dependence condition.

1 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to 2 the terms of community supervision for an offense under Chapter 49, 3 Penal Code, that is committed on or after September 1, 2005. The 4 terms of community supervision for an offense under Chapter 49, Penal Code, that was committed before September 1, 2005, are 5 6 covered by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of 7 this subsection, an offense was committed before September 1, 2005, 8 if any element of the offense was committed before that date. 9 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005. 10
