- 8 INFORMATION. (a) An election officer may access electronically
- 9 readable information on a driver's license or personal
- 10 identification card for proof of identification when determining
- 11 whether a voter shall be accepted for voting.
- 12 (b) The secretary of state shall prescribe any necessary
- 13 procedures to implement this section.
- 14 SECTION 2. Section 521.126(d), Transportation Code, is
- 15 amended to read as follows:
- 16 (d) The prohibition provided by Subsection (b) does not
- 17 apply to a person who accesses, uses, compiles, or maintains a
- database of the information for a law enforcement or governmental
- 19 purpose, including:
- 20 (1) an officer or employee of the department <u>carrying</u>
- 21 <u>out</u> [who accesses or uses the information for] law enforcement or
- 22 government purposes;
- 23 (2) a peace officer, as defined by Article 2.12, Code
- of Criminal Procedure, acting in the officer's official capacity;

- 1 (3) a license deputy, as defined by Section 12.702,
- 2 Parks and Wildlife Code, issuing a license, stamp, tag, permit, or
- 3 other similar item through use of a point-of-sale system under
- 4 Section 12.703, Parks and Wildlife Code; [or]
- 5 (4) a person acting as authorized by Section 109.61,
- 6 Alcoholic Beverage Code; or
- 7 (5) a person establishing the identity of a voter
- 8 <u>under Chapter 63, Election Code</u>.
- 9 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
