A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the use and placement of certain hunting blinds and 3 wildlife feeders. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 62, Parks and Wildlife 5 6 Code, is amended by adding Section 62.002 to read as follows: Sec. 62.002. CERTAIN PLACEMENT AND USE OF BLINDS AND 7 FEEDERS PROHIBITED. (a) In this section: 8 (1) "Hunting blind" means a temporary or permanent 9 structure designed to wholly or partly conceal a person from view 10 11 while the person hunts. 12 (2) "Wildlife feeder" means an automatic or manual 13 mechanical device designed to provide food to native or exotic 14 wildlife. (b) Except as provided by Subsection (c), no person may: 15 16 (1) place or build a hunting blind or wildlife feeder less than 150 yards from a fence that separates property owned by 17 18 one person from property owned by another person; or (2) hunt from or use a hunting blind or wildlife feeder 19 that is less than 150 yards from a fence that separates property 20 21 owned by one person from property owned by another person. 22 (c) This section does not apply to: 23 (1) a landowner who possesses a written agreement with an adjoining landowner that allows the placement of a hunting blind 24

1	or wildlife feeder less than 150 yards from a common fence or
2	boundary shared by the landowners; or
3	(2) a person hunting from or using a hunting blind or
4	wildlife feeder at a location that is allowed under a written
5	agreement between adjoining landowners.
6	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
