5	SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 43, Local Government Code,
6	is amended by adding Section 43.077 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 43.077. EFFECT OF MUNICIPAL ANNEXATION ON VOTING
8	RIGHTS. (a) This section applies only to a municipality with a
9	population of 1.5 million or more.
10	(b) Following annexation of any part of a municipal utility
11	district by a municipality, a registered voter of the district is
12	entitled to vote in an election of the municipality if the person
13	resides in either:
14	(1) the part of the district annexed by the
15	municipality; or
16	(2) the part of the district that is unincorporated
17	and is not within the extraterritorial jurisdiction of another
18	municipality.
19	(c) A district resident who is entitled to vote under
20	Subsection (b)(2) is treated as if the person were a resident of the
21	municipality for purposes of a municipal election.
22	(d) If a member of the municipality's governing body is
23	elected by only the voters residing in a territorial unit that does
24	not include the entire municipality, the municipality shall

designate the territorial unit in which the part of the district 1 2 described by Subsection (b)(2) will be included for purposes of that <u>election</u>. 3 4 (e) On or after the 15th day but before the fifth day before the date of the first election held in which the residents are 5 6 entitled to vote under Subsection (b), the municipality shall publish notice in the form of a quarter-page advertisement in a 7 8 newspaper of general circulation in the municipality notifying the 9 residents that they are eligible to vote in the election and stating the location of all polling places for the residents. 10 (f) This section does not apply to an election to which 11 Section 3a, Article VI, Texas Constitution, applies. 12 SECTION 2. A resident of a municipal utility district is 13

14 entitled to vote as provided by Section 43.077, Local Government 15 Code, as added by this Act, in a municipal election ordered after 16 the effective date of this Act, regardless of when a part of the 17 district was annexed.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
