## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

Τ	AN ACT
2	relating to motor vehicles equipped with recording devices.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Subchapter K, Chapter 547, Transportation Code,
5	is amended by adding Section 547.615 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 547.615. RECORDING DEVICES. (a) In this section,
7	"recording device" means a device that is installed by the
8	manufacturer in a motor vehicle and that does any of the following
9	for the purpose of retrieving information from the vehicle after an
10	accident in which the vehicle has been involved:
11	(1) records the speed and direction the vehicle is
12	traveling;
13	(2) records a history of where the motor vehicle
14	<pre>travels;</pre>
15	(3) records steering performance;
16	(4) records brake performance, including information
17	on whether brakes were applied before an accident;
18	(5) records the driver's safety belt status; or
19	(6) transmits information concerning the accident to a
20	central communications system.
21	(b) A person who sells or leases a new motor vehicle in this
22	state that is equipped with a recording device shall disclose that
23	fact in the owner's manual for the vehicle.
24	(c) A person who rents a motor vehicle in this state that is

- 1 equipped with a recording device shall disclose that fact to the
- 2 renter of the vehicle.
- 3 (d) Information recorded or transmitted by a recording
- 4 device may not be retrieved by a person other than the owner of the
- 5 motor vehicle in which the recording device is installed except on
- 6 court order or with the consent of the owner.
- 7 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
