H.B. No. 222

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to state funding for school districts that have not more
3 than 400 students in average daily attendance.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 42.103, Education Code, is amended by
6 adding Subsection (a-1) and amending Subsection (d) to read as
7 follows:

8 (a-1) The basic allotment of a school district that has not
9 more than 400 students in average daily attendance is adjusted by
10 applying the formula, of the following formulas, that results in
11 the greatest adjusted allotment:

12 (1) the formula in Subsection (b), (c), or (d) for
13 which the district is eligible; or

14 (2) $AA = (1 + ((400 - ADA) \times .0025)) \times ABA.$

15 (d) The basic allotment of a school district that offers a
16 kindergarten through grade 12 program and has less than 5,000
17 students in average daily attendance is adjusted by applying the
18 formula, of the following formulas, that results in the greatest
19 adjusted allotment:

20 (1) the formula in Subsection (a-1), (b), or (c) for
21 which the district is eligible; or

22 (2) $AA = (1 + ((5,000 - ADA) \times .000025)) \times ABA.$

23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
