1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Section 411.183(b), Government Code, is amended  
1-12 to read as follows:

1-13 (b) A renewed license expires on the license holder's  
1-14 birthdate, five [~~four~~] years after the date of the expiration of the  
1-15 previous license.

1-16 SECTION 2. This Act applies only to a license renewed on or  
1-17 after September 1, 2005.

1-18 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
