5	SECTION 1. Subchapter I, Chapter 545, Transportation Code,
6	is amended by adding Section 545.425 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 545.425. USE OF TELEPHONE; OFFENSE. (a) In this
8	section, "hands-free device" means speakerphone capability or a
9	telephone attachment or other piece of equipment, regardless of
10	whether permanently installed in the motor vehicle, that allows use
11	of the telephone without use of either of the operator's hands.
12	(b) An operator may not use a telephone while operating a
13	motor vehicle unless:
14	(1) the vehicle is stopped; or
15	(2) the telephone is used with a hands-free device.
16	(c) It is an affirmative defense to prosecution of an
17	offense under this section that the telephone was used to make an
18	<pre>emergency call to:</pre>
19	(1) an emergency response service, including a rescue,
20	emergency medical, or hazardous material response service;
21	(2) a hospital;

- 4 (d) This section does not apply to an operator of an
 5 authorized emergency vehicle using a telephone while acting in an
 6 official capacity.
- 7 (e) An offense under this section is a misdemeanor 8 punishable by a fine of:
- 9 (1) not less than \$25 or more than \$100 if the offense
 10 occurs outside a school crossing zone; or
- 11 (2) not less than \$125 or more than \$200 if the offense 12 occurs within a school crossing zone.
- 13 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
