8	(a) This section applies only to a permit required by a county to

LO	but does not apply to a permit for an on-site sewage disposal
L1	system.
L2	(b) Not later than the 45th day after the date ar
L3	application for a permit is submitted, the county must:
L4	(1) grant or deny the permit;
L5	(2) provide written notice to the applicant stating
L6	the reasons why the county has been unable to act on the permit
L7	application; or
L8	(3) reach a written agreement with the applicant
L9	providing for a deadline for granting or denying the permit.
20	(c) For a permit application for which notice is provided
21	under Subsection (b)(2), the county must grant or deny the permit
22	not later than the 30th day after the date the notice is received.

- 2 (1) may not collect any permit fees associated with
- 3 the application; and
- 4 (2) shall refund to the applicant any permit fees
- 5 <u>associated with the application that have been collected.</u>
- 6 SECTION 2. Subchapter Z, Chapter 233, Local Government
- 7 Code, as added by this Act, applies only to an application for a
- 8 permit submitted on or after September 1, 2005. An application for
- 9 a permit submitted before that date is governed by the law in effect
- 10 when the application was submitted, and the former law is continued
- in effect for that purpose.
- 12 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
