4	SECTION 1. Chapter 233, Local Government Code, is amended
5	by adding Subchapter Z to read as follows:
6	SUBCHAPTER Z. MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS

- 7 Sec. 233.901. TIME FOR ISSUANCE OF COUNTY BUILDING PERMIT.
- 8 (a) This section applies only to a permit required by a county to
- 9 construct or improve a building or other structure in the county,
- 10 but does not apply to a permit for an on-site sewage disposal
- 11 system.
- 12 (b) Not later than the 45th day after the date an
- application for a permit is submitted, the county must:
- 14 (1) grant or deny the permit;
- 15 (2) provide written notice to the applicant stating
- 16 the reasons why the county has been unable to act on the permit
- 17 application; or
- 18 <u>(3) reach a written agreement with the applicant</u>
- 19 providing for a deadline for granting or denying the permit.
- 20 (c) For a permit application for which notice is provided
- 21 under Subsection (b)(2), the county must grant or deny the permit
- 22 not later than the 30th day after the date the notice is received.
- 23 (d) If a county fails to act on a permit application in the

- 1 (b)(3), the county:
- 2 (1) may not collect any permit fees associated with
- 3 the application; and
- 4 (2) shall refund to the applicant any permit fees
- 5 <u>associated with the application that have been collected.</u>
- 6 SECTION 2. Subchapter Z, Chapter 233, Local Government
- 7 Code, as added by this Act, applies only to an application for a
- 8 permit submitted on or after September 1, 2005. An application for
- 9 a permit submitted before that date is governed by the law in effect
- 10 when the application was submitted, and the former law is continued
- in effect for that purpose.
- 12 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
